Various gifts,
bequests,
etc.,
sanctioned.

Item : Upon the re-marriage or death of my wife, whichever shall first happen, my executors, or the survivor of them, are directed to sell all my estate and all real estate purchased by them, and divide the proceeds of such sale or sale, together with all my other estate, as follows :

64. Five hundred dollars thereof I give to the Bethel United Brethren Church of Chewsville, Maryland, to be invested by the trustees of said church, and the interest therefrom to be used by them in defraying the expenses of running said church.

65. Two hundred dollars thereof I give to the Tunker Church, located on the south side of East Washington street, in Hagerston, Maryland.

66. Five hundred dollars I give to the trustees of the Bethel United Brethren Church of Chewsville, Maryland, to be invested by them and the income thereof applied in keeping the parsonage in repair, and if said church should purchase the property they now occupy as a parsonage, then to apply said five hundred dollars in part payment of the purchase money.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given, granted and declared to the acquisition by the several religious denominations or sects, orders or corporations hereinbefore in this Act mentioned or named, at any time hereafter, whether by gift, grant or otherwise, of the fee simple title to the lots or parcels of land aforementioned in which they are respectively entitled to a leasehold interest, or less than a fee simple title, by virtue of the several deeds, gifts, grants, bequests or devises aforementioned, and by virtue of the sanction hereinbefore by the first section of this Act given, and to the holding, sale, mortgaging, leasing or otherwise disposing of the same.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
