An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 674, 678, 688 and 689 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Liquors and Intoxicating Drinks," as re-enacted by the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Chapter 123 of the Session of 1898, and as since amended by the Acts of 1900, Chapter 278	474

An Act to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in any part of the district of Baltimore city bounded by Druid Hill Park on the south, the Western Maryland Railroad on the west, the northern boundary line of the city of Baltimore on the north and the Northern Central Railroad on the east.....	477
No. 280. An Act to repeal Section 238 of Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Somerset County," sub-title "State's Attorney," and to re-enact said section with amendments.....	478
No. 281. An Act to authorize the appointment of a joint special committee of the General Assembly of Maryland to act with the commission appointed by the State of Pennsylvania to confer with referenee to the propagation of food fishes in the waters of the Susquehanna river.....	479
No. 282. An Act to amend the charter of the Delta and Bel Air Electric Railway Company, a corporation organized under the Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, and to enlarge its powers.....	480
No. 283. An Act to authorize the trustees of the Grove Presbyterian Church in Harford county, Maryland, a body corporate, to acquire for the purposes of sepulchre only, land adjoining its burial ground or cemetery, by condemnation.....	483
No. 284. An Act to repeal Sections 147 to 168, both inclusive, of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Caroline County," sub-title "Greensboro," as amended by Chapter 738 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1900	484
No. 285. An Act to incorporate the town of Kitzmillersville, in District No. 13, in Garrett county, State of Maryland, by amending the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, Article 12, title "Garrett County," adding additional sections thereto, to be known as Sections 138 A, 138 B, 138 C, 138 D, 138 E, 138 F, 138 G, 138 H, 138 I, 138 J, 138 K, 138 L, 138 M, 138 N, 138 O, 138 P, 138 Q, 138 R, 138 S, and 138 T, and to follow immediately after Section 138 of said Article 12, and to be known by the sub-title "Kitzmillersville"	497
