

CHAPTER 477.

CHAP. 477

AN ACT to provide for a General Index of the Equity Records of Carroll County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the clerk of the Circuit Court for Carroll county, Maryland, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make a general index of the equity records of said county. General index to be made.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the County Commissioners of Carroll county be and they are hereby authorized and required to levy upon the assessable property of said county as other county charges are levied, a sum sufficient to pay for said indexing, unless the receipts from said clerk's office shall be enough to pay for said work after all his office expenses and salaries are paid, in which event it shall be paid from the receipts of said office. Levy to be made.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 478.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay Isaac Benesch & Sons, Minch & Eisenbrey, George Geddes, Uriah Pollock, and George Higgins, for furniture, etc., furnished the Senate and House of Delegates of Maryland.

Section. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of the State of Maryland in favor of Isaac Benesch & Sons for one thousand and thirty dollars and fifty-four cents (\$1,030.54); in favor of Minch & Eisenbrey, for five hundred and forty-three dollars (\$543.00); in favor of George Geddes, for one hundred and seventy-six dollars and fifty cents (\$176.50); in favor of Uriah Pollock, for one hundred and eight dollars (\$108.00); in favor of George Higgins, for three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). Warrant to be drawn.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
