Sanction and
consent
given.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly be and it is hereby given to the bequest to the Church of Christ in Hagerstown, Maryland, of the sum of one thousand dollars, as contained in the last will and testament of Sarah C. Eavey, late of Washington county, deceased, which will bears date March 25, 1904, and is recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for Washington county, in Liber J, folios 540, etc.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 506.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 110 of the Acts of 1892, repealing and re-enacting with amendments Section 188 of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Furs," relating to the protection of Muskrats and Otters in said county; also repealing Section 189 of the same Article 10, and re-enacting the same with amendments.

Repeal and
re-enact.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 188 of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Furs," as re-enacted by Chapter 10 of the Acts of 1892; also Section 189 of said Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows :

Game law.

188. No person shall trap, shoot or in any way or manner catch, kill or wound any muskrat or otter in Dorchester county between the fifteenth day of March and the first day of January in each and every year.

Game law.

188 A. It shall not be lawful for any person to shoot, trap or kill any muskrat or otter in Dorchester county at night by the aid of any reflector or other artificial light whatever.

Penalties
imposed.

189. Any person violating any of the provisions of the preceding section or sub-section shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than thirty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, or be confined in the Maryland House
