

town and Sharpsburg turnpike road; thence south, eighty-three degrees west, eleven hundred and sixty four feet to S. B. stone No. 5, planted on the west side of the road leading from Sharpsburg to Boyer's warehouse; thence south, eighty-three degrees west, two hundred and four feet nine inches to "S. B." stone No. 6, planted on the south side of the road leading from Sharpsburg to Snyder's warehouse; thence south, forty-eight degrees west, three thousand six hundred and ninety-six feet to "S. B." stone No. 7, on the west side of the Norfolk and Western Railroad Company's tract at Snyder's warehouse; thence south, thirty-three degrees west, six hundred and twenty-seven feet to "S. B." stone No. 8, on the west side of said railroad; thence south, forty-five degrees east, one hundred and nine feet six inches to "S. B." stone No. 9, on the south side of the National turnpike road leading from National Cemetery to Antietam station on the Norfolk and Western Railroad; thence south, eighty-five degrees east, one thousand nine hundred and eighty-four feet six inches to "S. B." stone No. 10, planted in fence line of out lots; thence north, eighty-one degrees east, eleven hundred and seventy-eight feet three inches to "S. B." stone No. 11, on the east side of out lot lane No. 2; thence north, seventy-five degrees east, three thousand and eighty-one feet to "S. B." stone No. 12, on the west side of Forge road; thence north, seventy-five degrees east, fourteen hundred and thirty-four feet to "S. B." stone No. 13; thence north, thirty-one and a-half degrees east, four hundred and sixty-four feet to "S. B." stone No. 14, on the north side of the Swamp road; thence north, thirty-one and a-half degrees east, ten thousand and thirty-six feet six inches to "S. B." stone No. 15, at southeast corner of Antietam National Cemetery; thence north, eight hundred and eight feet six inches to place of beginning, "S. B." stone No. 1; provided, however, that for sanitary and police purposes, the burgess and commissioners of Sharpsburg shall have and exercise full power and control for a distance one-half mile in every direction from said corporate limits.

Election of burgess. SEC. 5. The male citizens of Sharpsburg, of the age of twenty-one years and upwards, who have resided in the State of Maryland twelve months and in said town six months next preceding the election, shall, on the first Monday of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-four, and upon the same day in every alternate year thereafter, elect by ballot one citizen for **Assistant burgess.** burgess and one citizen for assistant burgess of said town, both of whom shall be citizens of the United States and five years
