

the county jail for not less than thirty days nor more than ninety days, in the discretion of the court; one-half of the fine imposed for a violation of this section to go to the informer, and the residue to the board of school commissioners of said county for the benefit of the public schools therein.

**Effective.**      SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
