

the additional limits provided for by this act, and all taxes whatever which they are authorized to assess, levy and collect within the taxable limits of the town of Saint Michael's, as existing before the passage of this act.

SEC. 150 F. *And be it enacted*, That the plat and survey of ^{Plat to be} the limits extended of said town of Saint Michaels, shall be recorded. recorded. recorded in the office of the clerk of the Circuit Court for Talbot county.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect ^{Effective.} from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 604.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 141, 142 and 157 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Allegany County," sub-title "Frostburg."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections 141, 142 and 157 of article one of ^{Repeal.} the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Allegany County," sub-title "Frostburg," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, to read as follows :

SEC. 141. On the first Monday in April, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and every second year thereafter, ^{Election of} there shall be one person elected by the qualified voters of said town of Frostburg to serve as clerk to said town, who shall keep minutes of the proceedings of the mayor and councilmen, which shall be subject to the inspection of all persons interested therein, and who shall perform all other duties ^{Treasurer.} pertaining to his office; the mayor and councilmen shall appoint a treasurer, who shall give bond, to be approved by the mayor, in such penalty and with such sureties as the mayor and councilmen shall prescribe, conditioned for a faithful performance of the duties of his office, and who shall pay moneys only on the order of the mayor and councilmen.

SEC. 142. There shall be one person to act as bailiff, and one person to act as night policeman, elected on the first Monday ^{Bailiff and} in April, 1895, and every second year thereafter, by the qualified voters of said town, who, before entering upon the duties ^{policeman.}
