Chapter 198.

AN ACT to repeal section three of chapter one hundred and seventy of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-four, entitled "An act to regulate the running of Traction Engines on the Public Roads of the State," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and
re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section three of chapter one hundred and seventy of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-four, entitled "An act to regulate the running of Traction Engines on the Public Roads of the State," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That one of the men accompanying such engine shall precede such engine at least three hundred yards to warn persons riding or driving upon any public road, of the approach of said engine, and shall assist such person or persons in the management of any horse or horses that may require his assistance to control the same.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
