

printed in Allegany county, of the manner, time and place of said sales, sell the part so laid off at public sale, and, after deducting the expenses of said sale and paying the sums levied as aforesaid, shall pay over the balance, if any, to the owner of said property.

SEC. 24. *And be it enacted*, That the said bailiff shall make return of the said levy, and all his proceedings therein, and about said sale, provided for in the preceding section, therein setting forth, the terms and length of notice, and manners, times and places of publication, or giving notice of said sale to the mayor and councilmen, who shall forthwith deliver all of the said returns, together with all the proceedings under which the same was made, to the clerk of the circuit court for Allegany county.

Bailiff to make return.

SEC. 25. *And be it enacted*, That upon return of said levy and proceedings to the circuit court, the same proceedings shall be had thereon as provided by the Code of Public General Laws for constable sales.

Proceedings in court.

SEC. 26. *And be it enacted*, That upon final notification and confirmation of said sale, by the circuit court for Allegany county, the mayor and councilmen, or the mayor and a majority of the councilmen, shall execute and deliver to the purchaser a deed of the property sold, with the seal of the town affixed, and the said deed shall convey to the purchaser the property sold.

Execute deed.

SEC. 27. *And be it enacted*, That the bailiff of said town may make all collections required of him at any time within the year for which he was appointed bailiff.

Collections—when made.

SEC. 28. *And be it enacted*, That the mayor and councilmen may appoint a supervisor or supervisors of the streets, lanes and alleys of said town, and direct in what manner the same shall be kept up and repaired, and may allow such supervisor such compensation for his services as they may deem reasonable.

Supervisor of streets.

SEC. 29. *And be it enacted*, That the bailiff of said town shall attend the meetings of the mayor and councilmen, when required, and perform such services as they shall direct; shall prevent the tumultuous and irregular meetings of dissolute and disorderly persons within said
