

Chapter 341.

AN ACT to change the name of Broad creek, Kent island, Queen Anne's county, to Broad Harbor.

Name changed to SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That "Broad Creek," Kent island, Queen Anne's county, an estuary of Chesapeake bay, shall hereafter be called and known as "Broad Harbor."

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 343.

AN ACT authorizing and directing the state librarian to furnish from the state library, for the use of the circuit court of Baltimore city, a set of Maryland reports.

Directed to furnish. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the state librarian be and he is hereby authorized and directed to furnish from the books now in hand, without detriment to the library, a complete set of Maryland reports, including Brantley's edition and down to sixty-fourth Maryland, inclusive, to the circuit court of Baltimore city.

Control of court. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the books to be furnished under the first section of this act, and that may hereafter be furnished for the use of said circuit court, shall be under the direction and control of said court, to be preserved and taken care of as said court shall direct.

Effective. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
