Chapter 6.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and seventy-two of the acts of assembly passed at January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-four, entitled "An act to authorize and empower the sheriff of Garrett county to employ a warden for the county jail of said county," and to enact a section in lieu thereof fixing the compensation of the sheriff of said county for conveying persons from said county to state institutions.

Repealed and section enacted in lieu.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That chapter two hundred and seventy-two of the acts of assembly passed at January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-four, entitled "An act to authorize and empower the sheriff of Garrett county to employ a warden for the county jail of said county," be and the same is hereby repealed, and that the following section be enacted in lieu thereof:

Compensation allowed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the sheriff of Garrett county shall be allowed for conveying persons under sentence from said county to any state institution the actual and necessary traveling expenses of said persons, and the actual and necessary traveling expenses of himself, to and from such institution, and also ten dollars a day as compensation for such service, but said sheriff shall not be allowed more than two days' compensation for any one trip to such institution.
