

time demand of any treasurer such other or further bond, with such other or further security as in their judgment the interest of the state may require.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the county commissioners shall provide and furnish the treasurer an office in the court-house building, or in some other building as near to the same as possible, in the town of Oakland, which office shall be plainly designated by external sign as the office of the county treasurer; and it shall be the duty of the treasurer to keep his said office open from nine o'clock in the forenoon until three o'clock in the afternoon, and to attend therein for the transaction of business in person, or by deputy, on every day in the week except Sunday and legal holidays, and except when he is absent from the town of Oakland for the purpose of collecting taxes, as hereinafter provided for. It shall be his duty to attend in person, or by deputy, in each election district of said county, two days between the first day of July and the first day of September in each year to collect and receive taxes; and he shall give at least ten days' notice of the time and place of such visits to the respective districts.

Furnish an office.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the county commissioners of said county shall make their annual levy for state and county taxes on or before the third Tuesday in April in each and every year, and the same shall be due and payable on the first day of August next succeeding the date of the levy thereof; from all tax bills for county purposes which shall be paid prior to the first day of September in the year of the levy thereof, a discount of five per centum shall be deducted from the amount thereof; from all such bills paid during the month of September succeeding the levy thereof, a discount of four per centum shall be allowed, and all taxes levied for county purposes remaining unpaid on the thirty-first day of December in the year of the levy thereof shall be in arrear, and interest shall be charged and collected thereon from the date when the same shall have been due and payable, to wit, on
