CHAPTER 406.

AN ACT making appropriations for the support of the State Government, for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That for the expenditures in the support of the State Government for the fiscal year beginning with the first day of October, eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, and ending with the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated, that is to say :

Appropriation for year ending September 30, 1899.

FOR STATE OFFICERS.

For the salary of the Governor, four thousand five hundred dollars ; for the salary of the Secretary of State, two thousand dollars ; for the salary of the Messenger to the Governor, one thousand dollars ; for the salary of the Comptroller of the Treasury, two thousand five hundred dollars ; for the salary of the chief clerk to the Comptroller, eighteen hundred dollars ; for the salary of two assistant clerks to the Comptroller, fifteen hundred dollars each, three thousand dollars ; for the salary of two assistant clerks to the Comptroller, twelve hundred dollars each, twenty-four hundred dollars ; for the salary of the Treasurer of the State, two thousand five hundred dollars ; for the salary of the chief clerk to the Treasurer, eighteen hundred dollars ; for the salary of two assistant clerks to the Treasurer, twelve hundred dollars each, twenty-four hundred dollars ; for the salary of two clerks to the State Tax Commissioner, twelve hundred dollars each, twenty-four hundred dollars ; for the salary of the State Librarian, fifteen hundred dollars ; for the salary of the Commissioner of the Land Office, fifteen hundred dollars ; for the salary of one clerk to the Commissioner of the Land Office, twelve hundred dollars.
