

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners and Election Supervisors of Prince George's county are hereby directed to make all necessary provisions for voting in said Election District No. 15, or "Mellwood District," as they are now required by law for other election districts in said county. Voting.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That there shall be a new general registration of all the legal voters in said Election District No. 15, or "Mellwood District," in the same way and under the same rules and provisions in all respects as provided by chapter 202 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the session of 1896, for the general registration of voters in the counties of the State. Registration.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the Governor of the State of Maryland and the County Commissioners of Prince George's county are hereby authorized and empowered to make the same appointments of justices of the peace, constables and other offices for said Election District No. 15, or "Mellwood District," as are now made for the other election districts of Prince George's county. Appoint-ments.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

#### CHAPTER 131.

AN ACT to add two additional sections to Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, entitled "Harford County," one under sub-title "Almshouse," to follow Section 20 of said Article, and to be known as Section 20 A, and the other under sub-title "Sheriff," to follow Section 253 and to be known as Section 253 A.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That two additional sections be added to Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Harford County," one under sub-title "Almshouse," to follow section 20 and to be known as section 20 A, and the other under the sub-title "Sheriff," to follow section 253 and to be known as section 253 A. Additional sections.

20 A. The Circuit Court for Harford county shall annually on or before the 10th day of March appoint three ladies, at least two of whom shall be residents of said county, to constitute a board of visitors for the almshouse, who shall serve without Appoint three ladies.
