

203. All shares of stock in any bank (other than a National bank) incorporated by or located in or doing business in this State, shall be valued and assessed for the purpose of State, county and municipal taxation to the owners thereof in the county or city in this State, in which said owners may respectively reside, in the same manner and to all intents and purposes as if the said shares of stock were shares of stock in a National bank located in this State, to the end that at no time shall the shares of stock in any bank incorporated by or located in or doing business in this State (other than a National bank), or the owner or owners thereof be liable for or subject to any other or greater taxation than the same, or the owner or owners thereof would be if the said shares of stock were shares of stock in a National bank located in this State.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That all Acts or parts of Acts, laws or parts of laws inconsistent herewith, to the extent of such inconsistency, be and the same are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 287.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 84 A and 84 B of Article XXVII of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "False Pretenses," relating to frauds and false pretenses upon hotel and livery-stable keepers, as amended and re-enacted by the Act of 1894, Chapter 418:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 84 A and 84 B of Article XXVII of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "False Pretenses," relating to frauds and false pretenses upon hotel and livery-stable keepers, as amended and re-enacted by the Act of 1894, Chapter 418, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:

Repeal.

84 A. Every person who shall by any false or fraudulent representations, or by any false show of baggage, goods or chattels, which are calculated to deceive any hotel proprietor, keeper or manager, obtain lodging or credit, or the use of any
