ARTICLE XXI.

TALBOT COUNTY.

CHAPTER 667.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 114, 115, 115A, 115B, 115C, 115D, 115E, 115F, 115G, 115H, 115I and 116 of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," subtitle "Fish," as amended by Chapter 696 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1900, and as further amended by Chapter 183 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1902, and to re-enact the same with amendments, subtitle "Terrapin and Crabs."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 114, 115, 115A, 115B, 115C, 115D, 115E, 115F, 115G, 115H, 115I and 116 of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," subtitle "Fish," as amended by Chapter 696 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1900, and as further amended by Chapter 183 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1902, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

SEC. 114. It shall be unlawful for any person to take, capture or destroy fish in the waters of Talbot County except as provided in the succeeding sections:

SEC. 115. It shall be lawful to catch fish in the waters of the Miles river and all of its tributaries, and in all the tributaries of the Wye and Great Choptank rivers lying solely in Talbot county, with gill nets or hook and line at any time, and it shall be lawful to catch fish in Skipton creek with haul seines from the first day of August to twentieth day of May following, and it shall be unlawful to set any net so that it will extend more than one-half the distance across the river or creek in which it may be set; and it shall be lawful to catch fish in all other waters of said county with hook and line at any time, and to take and catch fish with gill nets, haul seine, drag nets, fish
