Hand's Canal Line for Philadelphia; a vessel sails every day, extreme bad weather excepted, John W. Brown, agent, 65, Smith's wharf.

The Office of the Norfolk, Petersburg and Richmond Line of Packets kept at James Hooper & Sons, Light street wharf, or J. Y. Tomkins, Spear's wharf, start every Sunday.

STEAMBOATS.

Citizens' Union Line via. *New-Castle and Frenchtown Rail-Road*, carrying U. S. Mail, leaves the lower end of Bowly's wharf, South street, for Philadelphia, every morning at 6 o'clock, which may occasionally vary, during the summer months, of which due notice will be given in the papers of the day; they will also run a second line, provided the travelling will justify it.

For Norfolk, Petersburg and Richmond, Columbus, Captain Holmes; Pocahontas, Captain Sutton; leaves the lower end of Spear's wharf, three times a week, say Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays at one o'clock P. M. and arrives Mondays, Thursdays and Saturdays, from April to November; then twice a week till January; and once a week until March—the mail for Norfolk is carried in this line. The Norfolk, Capt. Parish, leaves same wharf with freight only, every other Saturday for the same places.

For Alexandria, Washington and Georgetown. The steam packets Fredericksburg, Captain B. J. Jenkins, and Columbia, Capt. James Mitchell, leave Commerce street wharf every Wednesday and Saturday afternoon at 4 o'clock; returning, one of these boats leaves the District every Sunday and Wednesday morning—from Washington at 5, and Alexandria at 7 o'clock. Governor Wolcott, Capt. Wm. W. Verdon, leaves Patterson-st. wharf, for Havre-de-Grace and Port Deposit, every Tuesday and Saturday, at 9 A. M.; returns on Wednesdays and Sundays at 4 P. M. A Stage from Lancaster, meets the Wolcott at Port Deposit. Also, for Rockhall, Centreville and Chestertown, every Thursday at 9 A. M.; returns on Friday at 4 P. M.

The Wolcott also leaves Baltimore every Monday at 6 A. M. for Fredericktown or Sassafras river, and returns the same day at 5 P. M.
