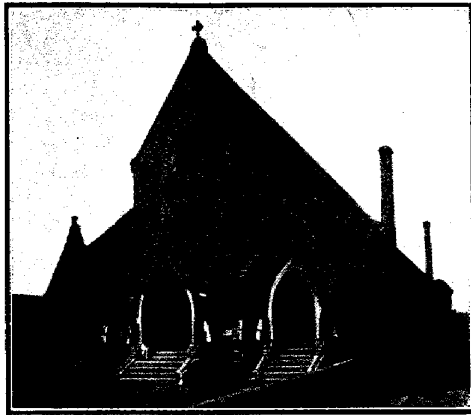


learning his trade, is now employed as assistant instructor at a salary of \$7.00 per week.
