


# PYTHIAN BUILDING

The Largest and most commodious building  
in the city for the exclusive use

The Building is four stories in height, steam heated and well ventilated. Situated at Twelfth and U Streets, N. W. Street car line passing the door, and another street car line one block east. There are ten (10) lodge rooms, each provided with ample ante-rooms with lockers.
