- $5.\ A$ large number of colored organizations, churches and individuals are cooperating with our Association. We also have a large representation of fairminded white people who are backing us, including churches, organizations and individuals.
- The Association for the Handicapped and all allied organizations have watched with interest the efficient and businesslike administration His Honor has given the citizens of Baltimore.
