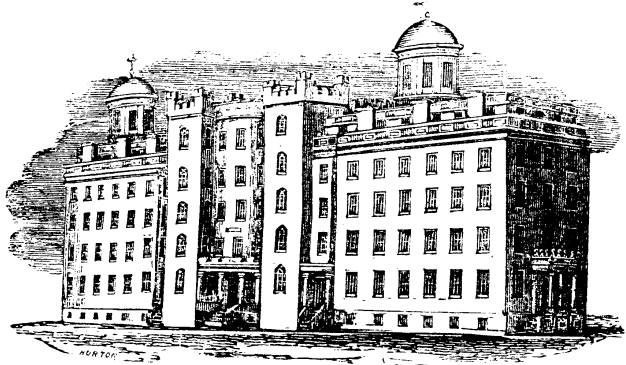

The Medical Faculty holds an annual Session of four months, beginning on the last Monday in October, and terminating on the first of March ensuing.

The spacious buildings erected for the special use of the Medical Department are located in the eastern section of the city, on

Broadway, near East Baltimore street.

They have been constructed solely for the purpose of instruction in the science of Medicine, by lectures and demonstrations. With this view a large wing has been appropriated to the uses of a HOSPITAL, in which are received private patients, and likewise, by an order from the United States Treasury Department, one half of the seamen of this port who may require medical relief. Another portion of the building has been expressly arranged for the accommodation of those students who may prefer to board and lodge in the college edifice, where comfortable private apartments will be furnished by the Steward of the institution, on reasonable terms.
