

CHAPTER 45.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money to pay John M. Carter for extra clerical services in the Executive Department, connected directly with the Adjutant General's Department of the State. Passed Feb. 24, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) be and the same is hereby appropriated to pay John M. Carter for extra clerical services in the Executive Department of the State of Maryland connected directly with the Adjutant General's Department of the State. Sum appropriated.

Sec. 2. *Be it enacted,* That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, shall pay to the said John M. Carter the said sum of five hundred dollars. Authorized to pay.

Sec. 3. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 46.

AN ACT to incorporate the Miles River Wharf Company, at Miles River Ferry in Talbot county. Passed Feb 24, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Reuben Tharp, Samuel T. Hopkins and Joseph Raisin, and their associates, successors and assigns, be and they are hereby created a corporation and body politic, by the name of the "Miles River Wharf Company," and by that name may have succession, and shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, in any court of law or equity in this State, and to make and use a common seal, to ordain and establish such by-laws and Incorporated.
