CHAPTER 181.

Passed March 7, 1862. AN ACT to authorize the Trustees of Primary School District, Number Thirty-one, of Frederick county, to sell and convey a School House and Lot in said District.

Authority to sell school-house and lot; application of proceeds. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Dr. William S. McPherson, Frederick Lightner and Israel Sweeny, Trustees of School District Number Thirty-one, in Frederick county, or their successors in office under the Primary School Laws of said county, be and they are hereby authorized to sell and convey to the purchaser, a school house and lot in said district, and to apply the funds from the sale thereof, to the erection of another school House in a more central part of said district.
