

## CHAPTER 24.

Passed Jan. 10, 1862. AN ACT to repeal an act to authorize the opening of a public road in Howard and Montgomery counties, passed on the second day of March, eighteen hundred and sixty.

Act repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the act to authorize commissioners to open a road in Howard and Montgomery counties passed on the second day of March eighteen hundred and sixty of the January session of the General Assembly of Maryland, chapter one hundred and fifty-two, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Commissioners authorized to pay expense incurred, &c. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners of Howard county and the commissioners of Montgomery county are hereby authorized to pay such reasonable expenses, except damages for land, which upon the return of the commissioners appointed by the act of eighteen hundred and sixty, chapter one hundred and fifty-two, to open said road, shall actually appear to have been properly incurred in the said counties, respectively.

In force. Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

## CHAPTER 25.

Passed Jan. 7, 1862. AN ACT to change the name of Charles Louis Durocher McLaughlin, to Charles Louis Durocher.

Name changed SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the name of Charles Louis Durocher McLaughlin, infant son of Doctor David Barnum McLaughlin and Maria Louisa McLaugh-
