

(11) To the gift and devise under the last will and testament of John Thorne, deceased, late of Baltimore City, to the Trustees of the Old School or Primitive Baptist Church of Baltimore City, said will being of record in the Register of Wills office of Baltimore City, in Wills Liber BES No. 96, folio 111, etc.
