

tion), title "Fish and Fisheries," to be known as Section 123, and to read as follows:

SEC. 123. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to whip or beat the waters of any river, creek, cove, inlet or tributary within the limits of this State with poles, sticks, or any other thing, for the purpose of driving fish into thresh nets, seines, nets, fish baskets, or any other contrivance for catching fish, and any person violating this section shall be subject to the fines and forfeitures prescribed by Section 115 of this Act.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect on June 1st, 1916.

CHAPTER 279.

AN ACT, to provide for the appointment of Road Commissioners in each and every District in Frederick County, by the Board of County Commissioners of Frederick County, prescribing the duties of such Road Commissioners and providing for their compensation in the several Districts.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Frederick County shall annually before the first day of February, after January 1st, 1917, appoint a road commissioner for each road district and road sub-district of the county, who shall hold office for one year unless removed for cause by the County Commissioners in their discretion or until his successor shall be appointed and qualify. They shall receive detailed instructions from the County Commissioners as to the method of their work, the time and manner of doing the same, and shall make a detailed report in writing to the County Commissioners at least every three months, showing the roads and bridges repaired, the amount of labor and money expended on each, and calling attention to such facts as require their consideration. It shall be the duty of the road commissioner so appointed to take direct charge and care on and in behalf of the County Commissioners of all roads and bridges in his district, and he shall see that no obstruction, hinderance or injury is permitted upon or to any of them.
