c. Deed to the same corporation by the name "The Presbyterian Church at Takoma Park of Montgomery County, Maryland," from Warner A. Childs and wife, dated October 13th, 1898, recorded October 26th, 1898, in Liber T. D. No. 6, folio 133 et seq., one of the Land Records of said Montgomery County.

(86) To the deed and gift from Margaret E. Maund, unmarried, to the Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church of the Fayette Street Station in the City of Baltimore, a body corporate, which deed is dated the 24th of January, 1834, and recorded among the Land Records of the City of Baltimore in Liber T. K. No. 234, folio 243, &c.

(87) To the deed dated the 18th of December, 1900, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore City in Liber R. O. No. 1880, folio 237, etc., from the Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church of the Fayette Street Station in the City of Baltimore, a body corporate, duly incorporated, to the German Evangelical Lutheran Jehovah Church of Baltimore City, a body corporate.
