CHAPTER 90.

An act to Divorce Jane Didier, of the City of Baltimore, from her husband Jefferson Didier. Passed Feb. 25, 1837.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Jane Didier of the City of Baltimore, be, and she is hereby divorced *Divorce.* a vinculo matrimonii, from her husband Jefferson Didier.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said Jefferson Didier, by virtue of his marriage with the said Jane Didier, shall not be authorized to have or claim any right, title or interest, in the estate, real, personal, or mixed, of the said Jane Didier, that shall be acquired by her after the passage of this act, either by gift, bequest or otherwise, nor shall the said Jane Didier, be entitled in any manner to have or claim any right, title or interest in the estate, real, personal or mixed, of the said Jefferson Didier, that shall be acquired by him after the passage of this act. *Claims released*

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted.* That the said Jane Didier, be, and she is hereby declared to be entitled to the custody and guardianship of her children by her marriage with the said Jefferson Didier, during said children's minority. *Guardianship*
