

CHAPTER 356.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 5-B of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Allegany County," as said section was enacted by Chapter 299 of the Acts of 1918, relating to the Bureau of Identification.

(Vetoed.)

CHAPTER 357.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Washington County," sub-title "Williamsport," to be known as Section 405-A, to follow immediately after Section 405 of said Article, relating to the election of town officers.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Washington County," sub-title "Williamsport," to be known as Section 405-A, to follow immediately after Section 405 of said Article, and to read as follows:

405-A. No person shall be voted for at any election provided for in the preceding section, and no person shall be eligible to hold any of the offices provided for in the preceding section, unless such person shall announce his candidacy for such office by publication in some newspaper published in Williamsport, Maryland, at least ten days before said election, or unless such person be nominated at some primary or meeting held by citizens of the town of Williamsport and the result of which primary or meeting has been announced by publication in some newspaper published in said Washington County at least five days before said election.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1920.
