Resolved, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to John Denpon, of the state of Ohio, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to his order, during life, in half yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a drumnier, as a further remuneration for his services during the revolutionary war.

A Resolution authorising the Sheriff of Frederick county, ** and February to discharge Philip Markley from the Gaol of said County, and for other purposes.

Resolved, That the sheriff of Frederick county be, and he is hereby authorised and directed, to discharge Philip Markley from god, upon the commitment for fine and cast, for the crime of assault and battery; and that the levy-count of mid county are directed to levy then fine, cost and charges, upon the assaysable property of the county.
