1834.

Resolution in favor of John D. Toy.

Passed Mar. 30, 1834

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, be and he is hereby authorised and directed to pay to John D. Toy, for printing reports for Messrs. J. T. Ducatel and J. H. Alexander, out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury, the sum of eighty-seven dollars.*

No. 2.

Resolution in favor of the Commissioners of Anne Arundel County.

Passed Feb. 14,

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay unto the Commissioners for Anne Arundel County, the sum of one thousand dollars, to be by them applied to defraying the expenses of arrest, prosecution and conviction of the rioters on the Baltimore and Washington Rail Road.*
