washing Lodging and Clothing sufficient for such an Apprentices to have and wear during the term of  
Whereupon the said William Roberson is Ordered to Give security to Comply with the Covenant of the same

free Consent is Appointed by the Court here as Guardian to a certain Child his Son and Infant  
The Age of fourteen years untill he the said Child should Arrive at full age by Law  
the Choosing of his Guardian & Whereupon the said Guardian is Ordered to take into his Care and Custody  
All the Estate of the said Child and it is further Ordered that certain Richard Smith and Thomas Sandys  
of Somerset County deliver up unto the said Stephen Sandys Guardian all the Estate of the said Child  
in Lands and Possession and that of Right doth belong unto the said Child and that the said  
Guardian Give Security to Comply with the Law in Relation to such Guardianship and do deliver up unto the  
said Stephen Sandys his heirs & Assignes as Guardian or Guardians hereafter to be Appointed or Chosen all the Estate  
of the said Child that he shall take into his hands and possession presently and directly when he thereunto
