A Copy of the foregoing Declaration was made and sent to be served on the defendant by all Able-bodied
besides the said Peterbridge Attorney by his Attorney at Law the Sheriff to wit John Dennis Esquire then returned that he
did the said John Weatherly whose Day here at this Day he had Prayed to Answer the said Peterbridge Attorney of the
place to him it was Commanded and further the same Sheriff returned that he had served the said John Weatherly with
a Copy of the foregoing Declaration according to Act of Parliament in such Case provided

Whereupon the said John Weatherly at the Request of the said Peterbridge Attorney is adjudged to give
Special Bail to the Action &c. Thereupon a Chain Knight Weatherly of Somerset County Esquire present herein
in his proper person undertook for the said John Weatherly that if it should happen that Judgment in the place of the
Prayers for the said Peterbridge Attorney against the said Weatherly that he the said John Weatherly should be
satisfied that then he the said John Weatherly should pay and satisfy unto the said Peterbridge Attorney the sum of the
Costs thereupon or under his hand in Execution of such Judgment to the Prison of the Sheriff of the County of Middlesex
thereof that he the said Chain Knight Weatherly will do the same for him &c.

And the said John Weatherly in his proper person with and Defendeth the same Judgment to be had
Prayer Leave thereof to be taken in full Court to be held at Quinns Ann Lane the third Sunday of March next
following and he hath it and the same day is given to the said Peterbridge hereafter &c.

At which Day here Comerswell the said Peterbridge Attorney by his Attorney at Law the said John
Weatherly in his proper person and the said Peterbridge Attorney prays that the said John Weatherly to his Declaration
may Answer Whereupon the same John hath until the second Day in May next to him Given by the Court his Answer
unto the said Peterbridge in the said place and thereupon the said John Weatherly at the same day solemnly called to
Answer Cometh not nor saith any thing for himself in Case or proclusion of the Action of the said Peterbridge
which the same Peterbridge Remains thereof against the said John Weatherly undisturbed

Therefore it is considered that the said Peterbridge Attorney Prayers against the said John Weatherly
his Debt of and his Damages by Decision of the Detention of the said Debt to
be paid of the same Peterbridge of his Asset by the Court here Judgment and the said John in May &c.
