CHAPTER 99.

*An act for the relief of James Allcorn, of the City of Baltimore.* Passed Feb. 28, 1833

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Insolvent act extended to.  
 That the Commissioners of Insolvent debtors for the city and county of Baltimore, be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered, to grant to James Allcorn, of the city of Baltimore, the benefit of the several acts of Assembly, passed for the relief of insolvent debtors; *Provided,* Proviso. the said James Allcorn, shall in all respects (except that of proving residence,) comply with the requisitions of said acts of Assembly, and that he satisfy the said commissioners that he did not come into this state with the view of obtaining the benefit of the insolvent laws.

CHAPTER 100.

*An act for the relief of Archibald T. Frink, of Washington county.* Passed Feb. 28, 1833

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Insolvent act extended to.  
 That the orphan's court of Washington county, be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered, to grant to Archibald T. Frink, of said county, the benefit of the several acts of Assembly, passed for the relief of insolvent debtors; *provided,* Proviso. the said Archibald T. Frink, shall, in all respects, (except that of proving residence) comply with the requisitions of said acts of Assembly, and that he satisfy the said orphans' court, that he did not come into this state with the view of obtaining the benefit of said insolvent laws.
