

full and effectual manner as any person or persons, bodies CHAP 229.
 politic or corporate, within this State, in like cases, may or
 can do or perform; and the said trustees or their succes-
 sors, or a majority of them, shall have full power and au-
 thority to have, make and use one common seal, with such
 device and inscription as they shall think proper, and there-
 with to pass and authenticate the certificates, acts, and or-
 ders of the said corporation; and the same seal, at their
 pleasure, to break, alter and renew.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the said trustees, and Powers of trustees.
 their successors, or a majority of them, from time to time,
 and at all times hereafter, shall have full power and author-
 ity to constitute and appoint professors, teachers, and as-
 sistants, for instructing the students and scholars of the
 said Academy in such sciences and branches of education
 as they shall think proper and suitable to be taught there-
 in; and to make ordinances and regulations for the good
 government of the said Academy, and the instruction of
 the youth aforesaid; and to appoint such number of their
 own body, not less than five, as they may think proper, to
 be a quorum or committee for transacting all general and
 necessary business of the said Seminary, and making tem-
 porary rules for the management thereof, and also to dele-
 gate to the said professors and teachers such powers and
 authorities as they shall think expedient for the government
 and discipline of the said Seminary, and the execution of
 the regulations thereof, and also to make such regulations
 for the direction, visitation, and examination of the said
 Seminary, and the students and scholars therein, as shall
 best promote the important objects of the Institution; *Pro-*
vided always, that the said ordinances be not repugnant to Provisio.
 the constitution and laws of this State.

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the said trustees and Semi-annual meetings.
 their successors, or a majority of them, shall meet at least
 twice in every year, in stated semi-annual meetings, to be
 appointed by their own ordinances, and at such other times
 as by their said ordinances, or by their own adjournments,
 they may direct, and when so assembled, they shall have
 power, from time to time, to appoint a President, Treasurer
 and Secretary, to make contracts with the professors or
 teachers, relative to the instruction of the scholars to be Choose officers, &c.
 placed under their care, and for the payment of their sala-
 ries, to examine the progress of the students and scholars,
 to hear and determine on all complaints and appeals, and
 upon all matters touching the discipline and government of
 the said Academy, and the execution of their ordinances,
