Robert Green and Daniel Flinn both of Kent County planters and present Lord in Court in their proper persons Acknowledge themselves Judged under y<sup>e</sup> said process of this province of Maryland in the Sum of ten pound Sterling money of Great Brittain to be bound of their Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if the said Bowles Green shall not make his personal appearance before the Justices of the next Court to be hold for y<sup>e</sup> County aforesaid at y<sup>e</sup> Court house in y<sup>e</sup> Town of Plover on y<sup>e</sup> third Tuesday of March next and if that in y<sup>e</sup> meantime he shall not be of good Behaviour wherewith y<sup>e</sup> said Robert Green and Dan. Flinn are content
