he should cause to come here twelve \mathcal{L} . by John \mathcal{L} . who hath
to the Quire \mathcal{L} . because as well \mathcal{L} . of which s^d precept the s^d Sher^{of}
to wit Fr^o. Hanson Gent^l now here at this Day to wit y^e 25th of
Days of March Anno Dom^o Seventeen hundred and twenty five
makes return that he hath here ready twelve \mathcal{L} . as by his precept he
was Commanded And now here afterwards to wit the Day and year
last mentioned come again as well the s^d Lord prop^y by Michael
Howard his Clerk of Judicements and as also the s^d Sarah Manning
who stands at the Bar and the Jurors of that Jury being impaneled
and called likewise came to wit Edward Dorrell William Dear
Elias Kingd Richard Davis John Wooddall Thomas Wilkins
Humphrey Younger William Crow Francis Burnoy Robert Greens
Samuel Morris & Robert Meek who being duly elected byed and sworn
to say the truth on the premises upon their oath Do say that Sarah Manning is
guilty of felonious by Stealing the said Diaper Napkin Linen Apron and
one yard of Country Coath as in y^e Judgment above mentioned

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here to wit at the Court house in y^e Town
of Chester in s^d County this 25th of Days of March Anno Dom^o Seventeen
hundred and twenty five that the said Sarah Manning stand in y^e pillory
for the space of quarter of an hour and that afterwards she receive at the
publick whipping post 9 of 1000 Lashes well laid on her bare back till y^e
blood appears as a punishment for her said Crime of felonious by Stealing
the said Diaper Napkin Linen Apron and one yard of Country Coath
according to the force form and Effect of the said Judgment and also it is Considered
that the s^d Sarah Manning pay the Sum of thirteen hundred & seventy
one pounds of Tobacco Costs accruing on the premises and to the officers
of this Court
