The s^d Sarah Manning having Entered ~~into~~ into Recognizance at
 last Court for her appearance at this Court to answer unto the Judgment
 aforesaid and now at this Court the s^d Sarah having appeared ordered that her
 recognizance and her Surety's Recognizance be Discharged

Sarah Manning of Kent County Minister at last Court did
 Enter into Recognizance in the Sum of twenty pounds Sterling
 in money of Great Britain to be Seized by Conditionally that if
 she should not personally appear at the then next Court to be held for
 Kent County to answer to an Judgment found against her for felony
 and if in the meantime she should not be of good behaviour and
 now to wit this fifteenth Day of March Anno Dom^o Seventeen Hun-
 dred and twenty five the Day of Appearance to s^d Recognizance the
 s^d Sarah appears and thereupon her Recognizance is Discharged

Samuel Berry and Charles Neal both of Kent County Planters at last
 Court did Enter into Recognizance in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling each to be
 Seized by Conditionally that if the s^d Sarah Manning should not
 personally appear at the then next Court to be held for Kent County to
 answer to the Judgment aforesaid and if in the meantime she should
 not be of good behaviour and now to wit this fifteenth Day of
 March Anno Dom^o Seventeen Hundred and twenty five the Day of
 appearance to s^d Recognizance the s^d Sarah appears and thereupon
 the s^d Samuel Berry & Charles Neal their Recognizances and either of them
 is Discharged

The Surety's are Discharged. the s^d Sarah was brought from the s^d Sheriff's Court to the Court house and she was discharged from the s^d Sheriff's Court.
 Ordered by the Court here that the Sheriff of Kent County keep the
 Sarah Manning in safe Custody until she shall satisfy the Court
 and restore the things themselves or value thereof in the whole
 amounting
