Robert Street of Trout County Plasterer at last Court as afo^r acknowledged himself indebted unto the Lord prop^r of this Province of Maryland in the sume of ten pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain to be Secured of his Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if he y^r same Robert should not make his personal appearance before the Justice of the Peace next Court to be hold for Trout County at the Court house in the Town of Chester ~~what should~~ be objected against him on his Lordships behalf on suspicion of abusing an ejection of s^r County and if that in the mean time y^r Robert should not be of good Behaviour And now at this Court hold the twenty first Day of June the s^r Robert having appeared his recogn^z is Discharged
