His Lordship - ordered by the Court that the said Katherine find  
 Katherine Banks } Security for her appearance at next Court to answer  
 to an Information for fornication and Good Be-  
 :haviour and that the Sher of West County keep her the said Katherine  
 in safe Custody untill she shall find Security as aforesaid

Thereupon Thomas Jones of West County Planter and present Prisoner  
 Court in his proper person doth Acknowledge himself indebted unto the  
 Right Hon. the Lord Prop. of this Province of Maryland &c. in the  
 Sum of ten pounds Sterling money of Great Britain to be made and  
 Leasid of his Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for y<sup>e</sup> use of  
 the said Lord Prop. his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the  
 said Katherine Banks shall not make her personal appearance  
 before the Justices of the next Court to be held for the County aforesaid at  
 the Court House in the Town of Chester in the said County on the third  
 Tuesday of August next ensuing to answer unto an Information  
 found against her for fornication and if that in the meantime she  
 the said Katherine shall not be of Good Behaviour wherewith the  
 said Thomas Jones's Content

The Court adjourns till Monday Morning at eight of y<sup>e</sup> Clock
