Right Hon<sup>e</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province of Maryland &c in the  
Sume of one hundred Sterling money of Great Britain to be made and  
Paid off his Goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements for y<sup>r</sup> use of  
the afo<sup>d</sup> Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of his Person and Precesors Conditionally that if the  
afo<sup>d</sup> Katherine Banks shall not make her personal appearance  
before the Justices of the next Court to be held for the County afo<sup>d</sup> at  
the Court House in the Town of Chester in the said County on the third  
Tuesday of August next answering to Answer unto an Information  
found against her for fornication and if that in the meantime the  
same Katherine Shall not keep Good Behavior wherewith the  
same Thomas Jones Content —

June 24.
