

Day of said Month Anno Dom 1726 came again the aft Lord propp. by Tench Francis Esq. of Incidents and the said John Jones and Thomas Jones nor either of them appearing thereon in the proceedings were continued until

the **third Tuzday** of August then next following — also

All which said August Court came again the aft Lord propp. by Tench Francis Esq. of Incidents and the said cause being continued until the **third Tuzday of August** following at which said Court the said Thomas Jones being brought to the Bar appeared thereon the said Tench Francis desired

the Court to proceed to Judgment on the verdict afo against the said Thomas Jones therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at the Courthouse in the Town of Chester in said County this **Sixteenth Day of August** Anno Dom 1726

that the said Thomas Jones stands one in the pillory one whole hour and afterwards he receive at the public whipping post twenty nine Lashes well laid on his bare back till the blood appears as a punishment for his aft crime of feloniously stealing a Hog according to the force form and Effect of the verdict afo also it is considered that the said Thomas Jones pay the sum of Eleven hundred Sixty Nine & a half pounds of Tobacco costs accruing on the premises afo to the Officers of this Court.

Ordered by the Court here at this Day to wit the Day and Year last mentioned that the Sheriff of Kent County take the aft Thomas Jones into custody and execute the punishment in the Judgment afo executed and also to bring him into Court again of which precept the said Just to wit John Fresham now High Sheriff of Kent County makes return in the Day and Year last said that he hath executed the said judgment and also hath now the said Thomas Jones before the Court.

John Walls and John Macey both of Kent County do come into Court in their proper persons and a promise to pay the four fold amounting to ten shillings Current Money of Maryland and the Costs in the Judgment afo executed and therefore the said Thomas Jones is therefrom discharged All which said August Court came again the aft Lord propp. by Tench Francis Esq. of Incidents and the said John Jones still made default and thereupon the same was further continued so far as relates to the same John until the **third Tuzday** of November then next following
