At His Lordships The Grand Jury for this County and at this Day with George Cooper. This was the second Day of March Anno Domini 1724. Seventeen hundred and twenty four. Came & made presentment of George Cooper of said County planter to this Court in these words viz

We the Jury do present ~~and~~ a certain George Cooper Senior for taking a false oath before Mr Thomas Kinggold Junr of the 20th 1724 in Langford Bay Lower hundred in St Pauls parish.

Thereupon it was ordered by the Court here that y^e said George Cooper Enter into recognizance with good security for his Appearance to the next Assizes to be hold for that County to answer unto what shall be objected against him on y^e presentment y^e And in the meantime to be of good Behaviour. Whereupon George Cooper of that County planter & present here in Court in his proper person doth Acknowledge himself ~~guilty~~ indicted unto the right
