And now at this Court to wit the fifteenth Day of June Anno Domini <sup>Seventeen</sup>  
 hundred and twenty five the s<sup>d</sup> Bowles Green Appearing their Recognizances  
 and either of them is Discharged

Ordered by the Court here that the s<sup>d</sup> Bowles Green Enter into Recognizance  
 with good Security for his Appearance at next Court to Answer unto an  
 Judgment found against him for Felony and Good Behaviour

Thereupon Bowles Green of Front County Planter present herein Court  
 in his proper person Doth Acknowledge himself Indebted unto the Right  
 Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of this <sup>Province</sup> of Maryland &c in the Sum of twenty  
 pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain to be made and Levied of  
 his Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for the use of the s<sup>d</sup> Lord  
 Prop<sup>r</sup> by his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the s<sup>d</sup> Bowles  
 shall not make his personal appearance before the Justices  
 of the next Court to be held for the County afo<sup>r</sup> at the Court House in the  
 Town of Chester in the same County on the third Tuesday of August  
 next ensuing to Answer unto an Judgment found against him  
 for Felony and if that in the mean time he shall not be of good  
 Behaviour wherewith the s<sup>d</sup> Bowles Doth Acknowledge himself  
 to be Content also

Robert Green and Daniel Flinn both of Front County afo<sup>r</sup> Planters  
 present herein Court in their proper persons do Acknowledge themselves  
 Indebted unto the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province of Maryland  
 in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain to be made  
 Levied of their several Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for  
 the use of the s<sup>d</sup> Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> by his heirs and Successors Conditionally that  
 if the s<sup>d</sup> Bowles Green shall not make his personal appearance  
 before the Justices of the next Court to be held for the County afo<sup>r</sup> at  
 the Court House in the Town of Chester in the same County on the third  
 Tuesday of August next <sup>ensuing</sup> to Answer unto an Judgment found against  
 him
