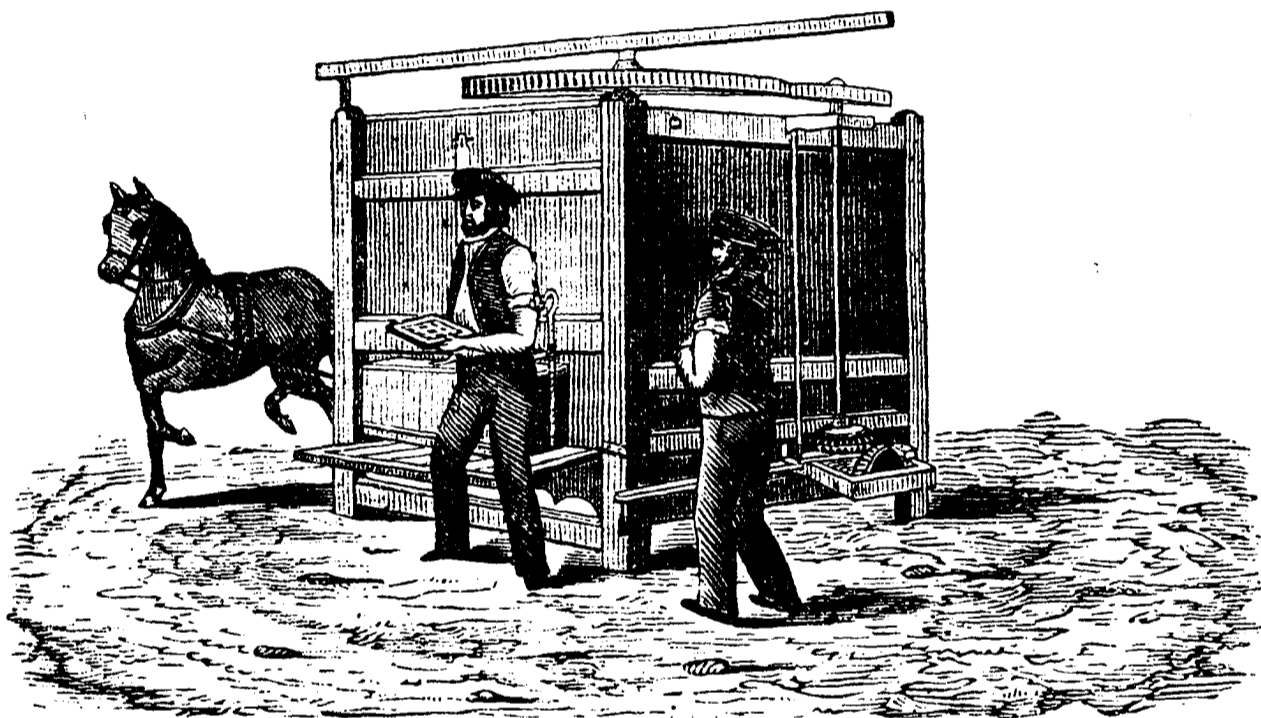


# DANNE'S NEW PATENT BRICK

# MACHINES



This machine is 4 ft. square, 5 ft. high in the rear.

## For Moulding Brick from Tempered Clay by Steam, Horse or Water Power.

This Machine grinds the Clay, and at the same time moulds the Brick. When worked by Horse Power, the horse being attached to the sweep, travels around the machine, which puts the grinding part into operation—the tube being filled with clay. To commence moulding, the Machine receives the moulds from the men, and delivers them again filled, and ready to be taken away.

This machine has been thoroughly tested, and is decidedly the best now in use for manufacturing Bricks. It will mould more Bricks in a given time, with the same amount of labor, and of better quality, than any other machine now in operation; and must, eventually, take the place of all others used for this purpose.

These Machines are made as ordered, to mould from Four to Six Bricks at a time, and of different sizes; and to be worked by Horse, Steam or Water Power—desired by the purchaser. The number of Bricks varying from 10,000 to 20,000 per day, according to the power applied. For further information, apply to
