On which the said John being in Court is ordered to give Security for his appearance to next Court and good behavior in the mean time. Whereupon the said John Camble in Court here present in his proper person acknowledged himself indebted to the Right Hon. of the Lord Proprietor in the sum of four pounds Stere to be levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if he shall not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be held for said County on the third Tuesday in August next ensuing and in the mean time he is to be of good behavior whosoever he acknowledges himself to be therewith content

Also at the same time came John Ashley and John Sturgis both of Kent County Planters and acknowledged themselves indebted to the Right Hon. the Lord Proprietor in the sum of five pounds Sterling each to be levied on their body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the same John Ashley shall not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be held for said County on the third day in August next ensuing and in the mean time he is to be of good behavior whosoever the said John Ashley and the said John Sturgis acknowledge themselves to be therewith content
