Kennard of Kent County, Plaintiff & Present her on Court in his proper Person doth Acknowledge himself Indebted into the Lord prop^y of this Province of Maryland in the sum of ten pound sterling money of Great Britain to be made and Satisfied &c. Conditionally that if the said Jane should not make her personal appearance before the Justice of the then next August Court And in the mean time to be of good behaviour Where with the said Nath. Kennard is Content

Eliz. Walker Sero. to Mr. Harris Considered by the Court here to wit the day and year last mentioned that the Sher^{of} of Kent County take the said Eliz. Walker into his Custody and Execute

the punishment in the Judgment afo specified and afterwards to bring her in to Court again of which precept the said Sher^{of} to wit John Gresham Gent. high Sher^{of} of Kent County makes return on the day and year last said that he hath executed the Judgment afo And also hath heard the said Eliz. before the Court

Ordered by the Court here that the said Eliz. Walker serve her said Master at the Expiration of her Service the space of six months for the trouble & Disgrace of his house And Ordered by the Court that Mr. Harris is Master to the said Eliz. be allowed for the maintaining of the said Child five months in next Levy the sum of four hundred pounds of Stob.
