A certain Mary Toboe at last June Court as an Indictment against the said Margret Flinn
 was obliged to give Security for her appearance to this Court. The same now appears and is
 prayed that the Security & recognizance for her app. may be discharged. ordered by this Court here
 that the same be discharged as prayed no person showing any cause to the contrary. Laughlin Flinn
 at last Court entered into recognizance in the Sum of twenty pounds for the said Mary Toboe
 appearance to this Court to wit on her & her Sureties against the said Margret Flinn
 in the said cause. The Court here discharges the same

A certain William Murphy at last June Court as an Indictment against the said Margret Flinn
 in the said cause was obliged to give Security for her appearance to this Court. The same
 William now appears and prays his recognizance and his Sureties may be discharged. ordered by
 the Court here that the same be discharged as prayed. William Murphy and
 his recognizance in the Sum of ten pounds for and Henry Collops in ten pounds
 for his appearance are by this Court here discharged
