There being an Indictm^t of fornication found against him. Whereas Philip Carroll vñ his Pro^r Person appears and saith that he is no sort guilty of the fornication upon him Imposed as by the same Indictm^t is alledged and therof he putteth himself upon his Country Philip Carroll vñ his Person and he who follows for the said Pro^r in like manner saith he is guilty

Frame^d Indictm^t

Ordered by the Court whereupon that the same Philip Carroll vñ his Person to Appear before the Court to be held for said Country on the third Tuesday in March next

Philip Carroll of Kent County and comes unto Court and acknowledge him selfe Indebted to the Right Hon^rble the Lord Proprietor in the sum of one hundred Pounds Sterl to be recovered on his body goods and Chattels Goods and Fementes to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors Conditionally That if the afo^r Philip Carroll Shall not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be held for said Country on the third Tuesday in March next Hene and there to Answ^r unto the afo^r Indictm^t of fornication wherewith he doth acknowledge himselfe content

likewise at the same Court came Robert Key of the afo^r County of Kent and acknowledged himselfe Indebted to the Right Hon^rble the Lord Proprietor in the sum of one hundred Pounds Sterl to be recovered on his body goods and Chattels Goods and Fementes to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors Conditionally That if the afo^r Philip Carroll Shall not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be held for said Country on the third Tuesday in March next Hene and there to Answ^r unto the afo^r Indictm^t of fornication he shall be objected ag^r the afo^r Indictm^t and in the mean time he is to be of good behav^r wherew^r he doth acknowledge himselfe content

Ordered by the Court here that Securly be given for Margaret Falconer as an Ind^r against the afo^r Philip

Morrells^r William Frisby of Kent County doth acknowledge himselfe Indebted to the Right Hon^rble the Lord Proprietor in the sum of two hundred Pounds Sterl to be made & recovered on his body goods & Chattels Goods & Fementes to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs & Successors Conditionally That if the afo^r Margaret Falconer Shall not appear and answer to her Ind^r and Lord Ship in the cause ag^r the afo^r Philip Carroll at next March Court to be held for said Country on the third Tuesday in March wherewith he doth acknowledge himselfe content
