Therefore it is Considered by the Justice here to wit this 20th Day of August Anno Dom^o 1720 between hundred twenty eight and that the said Jan^{et} Howard be fined the sum of two hundred & fifty pounds of tob^o for the use of his said Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Prop^y of this Province as a fine for committing the offense as and as Comfort as also it is Considered that the said Jan^{et} Howard pay the sum of three hundred and six pounds of tob^o Costs and charges on the promisor as to the officers of this Court And Ordered by the Court that she give Security for her fine & fees as Upon which Nathaniel Howard Husband of the said Jan^{et} Howard come into Court & Assures to pay the said fine for amount of the said Jan^{et} in Discharge of the Judgment as and also to pay the fees to the officers to whom they become Due
